The first short-term joint staff training was organized by UniTS - Università del Terzo Settore in Pisa/Italy between 6-11 June 2016 . 20 participants from the partner organizations attended the training. Main objective of the training:

- ◇ To get information about the regulations in Italy and the European Union for services to be provided for individuals with special educational needs,
- ◇ To get detailed information about the Italian system in terms of individuals with special educational needs,
- ◇ To be informed about the in-service training opportunities provided for professionals who are working with individuals with special needs,
- ◇ To make observations at the institutions which provide services for individuals with special needs,
- ◇ To discuss training outcomes with the participants.

The second short-term joint staff training was organized by Christliches Jugenddorfwerk Frechen im Verbund NRW Süd (CJD BBW Frechen) between 29 August -2 September 2016 in Frechen/Germany. 19 staff from partner organizations attended the training.

Main objectives of the training:

- ◇ To capture the vision of the European Union in order to contribute the training program/curriculum is being designed for teachers and other professionals who are working with individuals with intellectual disabilities,
- ◇ To get information about similar training programs in the German system,
- ◇ To observe existing practices at the organizations which provide services for individuals with special needs,
- ◇ To discuss training outcomes with the participants.
